

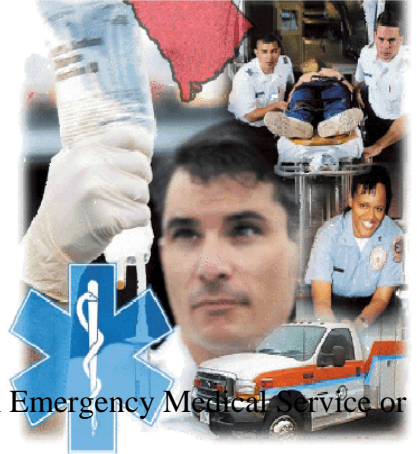
# EMERGENCY MEDICAL TECHNICIAN INTERMEDIATE HSC 5560

## Program Overview:

Participants receive medical knowledge to provide care to the ill and injured at the scene and in route to the medical facility. This course includes Roles and Responsibilities of the EMT I, Medical Legal Considerations, Communications and Documentation, Advanced Airway Management, Review of Shock Management, EMS Operations, Medical Emergencies, and Special Considerations, Patient Assessment and more.

## Program Requisites:

- Students must be a Basic EMT prior to course and must be affiliated with an Emergency Medical Service or Squad.
- Must maintain current SC or NR EMT throughout the course
- Must maintain current Basic Life Support credential throughout the course
- Successful Current ASSET, COMPASS, or HOBET test completion is required prior to entrance into course.

# **STUDENT REQUIREMENTS**

## **YORK TECHNICAL COLLEGE**

### **EMT INTERMEDIATE**

- Students must be a Basic EMT prior to the course and must be affiliated with an Emergency Medical Service or Squad that has a medical control
- Must be 18.
- Students must maintain current SC or NR EMT throughout the course.
- Students must maintain current BLS certification throughout the course
- Students must complete an application and bring 1<sup>st</sup> class day (**Enclosure 2**)
- Students must turn in a completed health form to their instructor prior to clinical rotation (no older than 1 year)- **by class 9**
- Students will have a criminal background check done prior to clinical rotation. A fee of \$68 has to be paid to the business office at York Technical college before course admission for credit students
  - Contact business office at York Tech 803 327-8027
- Credit Students must purchase malpractice insurance. A fee of \$69 has to be paid to the business office at York Technical College before course admission (included in tuition for CE students).
  - Contact business office at York Tech 803 327-8027
- Students must meet minimum York Technical College placement test scores (no older than 3 years for credit students, no age limit for CE students).
  - Requirements for York Tech Admission for EMT I (EMS 112) and Paramedic course are 81R-70W-54 pre algebra (or proof of successful completion of remediation courses at York Tech, approved SAT scores, or HOBETT 42/42)

Students must be affiliated with a squad or EMS agency that has a medical control that has to be documented on their course completion cards

*If student taking course for CE hrs only, no health form, CBC, malpractice, or score test is required- it is mandated they take 36 of the 64 for refresher. They may sit in for entire course leaving them only 8 hrs of CE to take for recertification. They are charged the course amt minus Malpractice Insurance fee and Criminal Background Check fee.*
