Program Overview:

The skills of CPR for victims of all ages and for varied target groups are taught. Some courses will present ventilation with a barrier device, bag-mask device and oxygen, relief of foreign body airway obstruction. Some of the courses will combine information and skills needed to provide layperson basic life support. The use and operation of the Automated External Defibrillator will be taught. Successful completion of the CPR receives registration through the American Heart Association.

Program Cost:

\$50. Book available at York Technical College bookstore.

Special classes may be set up for identified groups of six or more, at your location or on campus, at a time and day suitable to the students.
