# PHLEBOTOMY

## HSC 588

### Program Overview:

This course provides a basic introduction of the proper techniques and procedures for collecting blood specimens. Topics include professionalism, safety, medical terminology, anatomy, isolation, nursery, and special collection techniques. **No clinical experience is provided.** The course is 15 hours in length and is taught in five 3 hr segments. It is especially useful for persons working in health care that need phlebotomy credentialing. Students finishing this course, **after 1 yr. experience and documenting 25 venous punctures and 5 capillary sticks you will be able to take the National Competency Exam to become a Certified Phlebotomist.** High School diploma or GED required.
