**Who can attend?** The first 50 young women in the 6th to 9th grades and their mothers (although aunts, grandmothers, guardians, or dads are welcome) to register

This one-day workshop at York Technical College shows young women, through hands-on activities, that engineering is a fun and exciting career. The workshops will be held in the college's labs and classrooms. Sign-in, opening and closing ceremonies, will be held in the Student Center on the main campus.

# Student Activities

The day focuses on the three experimental sessions the young women will attend throughout the day, The workshops are hands-on with a "product" that the student can take home, whenever possible, that relates to an engineering or technology career. Workshop leaders will be women engineers or engineering technologists. Students will be given ribbons for 1st and 2nd place and overall prizes in selected sessions will be awarded at the end of the day.

Activities will be chosen by the hostesses.

**The college will be closed Saturdays and Sundays, November 24-26 and December 20—31.**

# Adult Activities

More than 65% of high school students say they discuss their choice of career with their mother. This program provides an opportunity for interested mothers (or other responsible adult) to learn how to help their girls in areas such as: choosing colleges, and careers. Guest speakers will be on hand to answer questions.



# Registration
