Young Entrepreneur Contest Criteria

Middle School Entry Criteria

Attending a middle school in York, Chester, or Lancaster County

Business idea is unique or has unique qualities

Business concept is student's idea (not parent's nor that of another adult)

Good communication skills required as displayed in business plan and video..

Contestants must complete the application and submit a business plan (using the outline provided at <http://www.yorktech.com/en/YECbp.doc>. It should be one to three pages – double spaced. Top, bottom, and left margins must be 1 inch. Right margin must be 2 inches. Cover page can be the fourth page.

Student name, business name, student's address, and contact information – phone number and/or email address, mailing address, and school name and grade must be included on the cover page for the business plan. Contestant name must be in the heading of each page of the business plan. Any other documentation (marketing materials, etc., may also be submitted).

Contestants must also submit a 2.5—5 minute video-taped presentation where they present an overview of their business. If assistance is needed with producing the videotape, please let us know (contact information is provided on page 4 of this document).

Entries must be submitted by **March 1 (postmarked by February 27, if mailed)**.

Family members of judges and committee members are ineligible to participate in the contest.

Two categories of winners: Middle school entrepreneurs and high school entrepreneurs

1st prize – both categories: \$500 plus other business-related items

2nd prize – both categories: \$250

3rd prize – both categories: \$100

The contestants from each category will be invited to the May 25 Young Entrepreneur Contest where the winner of each category will be announced.

Contestants' information will be displayed in an exhibit along with their photograph and biography (from the application).

Business plans will remain confidential unless written consent to display the information is provided by the contestant.

Organizers will not be responsible for loss or damage to submitted materials.

Organizers will disqualify submissions that are plagiarized.

Judges' decisions will be final.
